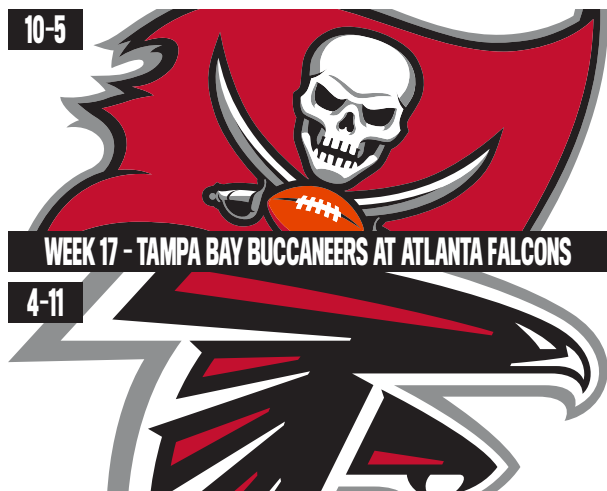

TACKLING ON THE TOUCHDOWNS

· In just one half of play at Detroit in Week 16, Tom Brady threw for 348 yards and four touchdowns. Over his last two halves, Brady has thrown for 668 yards and six touchdowns, becoming the first player to record 600+ passing yards over a four-quarter span in the last 40 years.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett has **27.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **1.0 more** to pass Rondé Barber (28.0 from 1997–2012) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.

TOM BRADY

- Brady has thrown for at least two touchdown passes in six consecutive games, tied for the longest such streak in team history. With **two touchdown passes** against Atlanta, he would establish a new franchise record.
- Brady has two-or-more touchdown passes and zero interceptions in three consecutive contests. With at least **two touchdown passes and no interceptions** against Atlanta he will tie Josh Freeman (2012) for the longest streak of such games in team history.
- Brady has **36 passing touchdowns** this season. He needs **four more** to post his second career season with at least 40 passing touchdowns, joining Aaron Rodgers (three), Drew Brees, Peyton Manning and Dan Marino (two each) as the only players in NFL history to throw at least 40 touchdowns in multiple seasons.
- With **a start** against Atlanta, Brady will have 299 career regular season starts, surpassing Brett Favre (298) for the most in NFL history.
- Against Atlanta, Brady will appear in his **301st career NFL game**, surpassing John Kasay for the 10th-most games played in NFL history. Brady ranks third among non-specialists, trailing only Jerry Rice (303) and Brett Favre (302).



ANTONIO BROWN

- Brown has **875 career receptions**, the 24th-most in NFL history. He needs **eight more** to tie Keenan McCardell (883 from 1992–2007) for the 23rd-most receptions in NFL history.
- Brown has **11,608 career receiving yards**, the 32nd-most in NFL history. He needs **12 more** to pass Calvin Johnson (11,619 from 2007–2015) for the 31st-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Brown has **77 career touchdown receptions**, tied for the 32nd-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to pass Joey Galloway (77 from 1995–2010) for the 32nd-most and **two more** to tie Harold Carmichael (79 from 1971–84) and Charley Taylor (79 from 1964–1977) for the 30th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.



CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has **29 career touchdown catches**. He needs **two more** to tie Kevin House (31 from 1980–86) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.

LAVONTE DAVID

- David has **three career defensive touchdowns** and needs **one more** to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979–96; Mike Washington, 1976–84).
- David has started 136 games in his NFL career. With **a start** against Atlanta, David will tie Buccaneers Ring of Honor member Mike Alstott (137 from 1996–2007) for the fifth-most starts by a Buccaneers player in franchise history.



CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin has **3,323 career receiving yards**, the 10th-most in franchise history. He needs **37 more** to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981–87) for the ninth-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has **22 career touchdown receptions**. He needs **one more** to tie Bruce Hill (23 from 1987–91) for ninth-most and two more to tie Dave Moore (24 from 1992–2001, 2004–06) for the eighth-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR

MIKE EVANS

- Evans caught 10 passes for 181 yards and two touchdowns at Detroit. With **at least 10 receptions for 175 or more yards and two touchdowns** against Atlanta, he would be the first player in NFL history to record consecutive games of that nature.
- With **at least 175 receiving yards and two receiving touchdowns** against Atlanta, Evans would join Issac Bruce (Weeks 5-7, 1995) and Chad Johnson (Weeks 10-11, 2006) as the only players in NFL history to post consecutive games with at least 175 receiving yards and two touchdowns.
- Evans has **960 receiving yards** this season and needs **40 more** to become the first player in NFL history to record at least 1,000 receiving yards in each of his first seven seasons.

ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has **86 regular season receiving touchdowns**, the 15th-most in NFL history. He needs **one more** to tie Andre Reed (87 from 1985-2000) for 14th-most and **two more** to tie Don Maynard (88 from 1958-1973) for the 13th-most regular season touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Including the postseason, Gronkowski has **98 receiving touchdowns** and needs **two more** to tie Don Hutson (100) for the 11th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).

LESEAN MCCOY

- McCoy has **73 career rushing touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to tie Earl Campbell and Leroy Kelly (74) for 26th-most regular season rushing touchdowns in NFL history.
- McCoy has **90 career scrimmage touchdowns**. He needs **one more** to tie Issac Bruce, Edgerrin James and Ricky Watters (91) for the 31st-most touchdowns in NFL history.

JASON PIERRE-PAUL

- Pierre-Paul has **30.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Brad Culpepper (33.0 from 1994-99) for seventh-most in franchise history.
- Pierre-Paul has **9.5 sacks** this season. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Simeon Rice (12.0 in 2004) for the 10th-most in a single season in franchise history.

RYAN SUCCOP

- Succop has contributed **122 points** this season. He needs **one more** to tie Connor Barth (123 in 2012) for fifth-most, **two more** to tie Matt Gay (124 in 2019) for fourth-most, **four more** to tie Martin Gramatica (126 in 2000) for third-most, **six more** to tie Gramatica (128 in 2002) for second-most and **nine more** to tie Bryant (131 in 2008) for the most points in a single season in franchise history.



NDAMUKONG SUH

- Suh has **started 145 consecutive games**, the second-longest active streak in the NFL, trailing only Philip Rivers (237).

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- The Buccaneers recorded 588 yards of offense at Detroit. With **at least 550 yards of offense** against Atlanta, they would be one of only four teams in NFL history to post consecutive games with at least 550 yards of offense (1985 Bengals, 1950-51 Rams, 1950 Detroit Lions).
- The Buccaneers have scored at least 24 points in six consecutive games, tied for the longest such streak in team history. With **24 or more points** against Atlanta, they would establish a new franchise record.
- Quarterback **Tom Brady** and tight end **Rob Gronkowski** have connected for **84 touchdowns** in the regular season and need **one more** to tie Steve Young and Jerry Rice (85) for the third-most touchdown connections in NFL history.
- The Buccaneers have scored **448 points** this season, the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **11 more** to pass 2019 (458) the most points in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have totaled **5,660 net yards** this season, the sixth-most in a single season in team history. They need **155 more** to pass 2017 (5,814) for fifth-most, **161 more** to pass 2012 (5,820) for fourth-most and **355 more** to pass 2015 (6,014) for the third-most yards in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **336 first downs** this season, tied for the sixth-most in a single season in team history. They need **five more** to pass 2016 (340) for fifth-most, **nine more** to pass 1984 (344) for fourth-most, **17 more** to pass 2017 for third-most and **18 more** to pass 2019 (353) for the second-most first downs in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have **47.0 sacks** this season, tied for the second-most in a single season in team history. They need **one more** to pass 2019 (47.0) for second-most and **eight more** to tie 2000 (55.0) for the most sacks in a single season in team history.

TURN BACK THE CLOCK

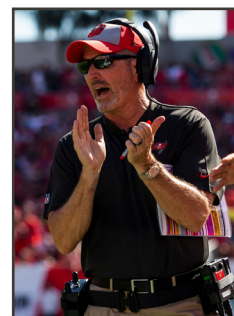
A pair of former Buccaneers head coaches will square off against their old team on Sunday as Falcons Interim Head Coach **Raheem Morris** was the head coach in Tampa Bay from 2009-11 after spending the 2007-08 seasons as the defensive backs coach. Morris also worked for the Buccaneers earlier in his coaching career, holding multiple defensive coaching positions from 2002-05. - Buccaneers Offensive Quality Control Coach **John Van Dam** was an Offensive Quality Control/Assistant Quarterbacks at Florida in 2015 when Falcons WR **Brandon Powell** (2014-17) played for the Gators.

- Buccaneers Defensive Quality Control Coach **Tim Atkins** was a defensive assistant with the Miami Dolphins in 2007 when Falcons Defensive Safeties Coach **Chad Walker** (2005-07) was a defensive quality control coach and Falcons Defensive Assistant **Lance Schulters** was a safety in Miami.
- Buccaneers Special Teams Coordinator **Keith Armstrong** held the same position with the Miami Dolphins from 2001-07 and worked with Falcons Running Backs Coach **Bernie Parmalee**, who was a tight ends/special teams coach in Miami from 2002-04.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** was a safety for the Washington Football Team from 1992-93 when Falcons Offensive Line Assistant **Bob Kronenberg** played for the organization as well.
- Buccaneers Offensive Line Coach **Joe Gilbert** held the same position at the University of Illinois in 2009 when Falcons Offensive Assistant **Danny Breyer** was a student assistant for the Illini.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

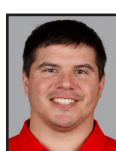

RAHEEM MORRIS



Raheem Morris entered the season as the defensive coordinator for the Atlanta Falcons and was promoted to interim head coach on October 12, 2020. Since his promotion to interim head coach, Morris has led the Falcons to a 4-3 record (.571).

A veteran coach with 18 years of NFL coaching experience on both the offensive and defensive sides of the ball, Morris is in his sixth season with the Falcons and his first as the defensive coordinator/interim head coach.

RAHEEM MORRIS AT A GLANCE

- Morris began the 2019 season focused on the receiving corps but turned his attention to the secondary after the bye week following a tumultuous start. Over the final eight games, the team went 6-2 and the defense went from having the lowest amount of takeaways in the first half of the season (4) to finishing with the second-most in the NFL (16) after Week 9. The defense also vaulted from the bottom of the league rankings to the top 10 in sacks (32nd to 10th), scoring efficiency (32nd to 9th), and red zone efficiency (31st to 6th) over the final eight weeks of the season.
- Morris joined the Falcons after spending three seasons as the defensive backs coach for the Washington Football Team. In 2012, he helped Washington's defense finish tied for fifth in the NFL with 31 takeaways.
- Prior to arriving in Washington, Morris spent three seasons as the head coach of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers from 2009-2011. He was the league's youngest head coach in 2009 and in 2010, his team finished with a 10-6 record. The Buccaneers made their best turnaround in franchise history in 2010 after going 3-13 in 2009.
- Morris served in multiple capacities with the Buccaneers during two different stints with the team before he was promoted to head coach. He spent two seasons as the team's defensive backs coach from 2007-08, during which time the Buccaneers allowed only ranked second in the NFL allowing 170.5 passing yards per game. During that span, the Buccaneers ranked among the league leaders with 22 interceptions.
- Morris made his NFL coaching debut with Tampa Bay as a defensive quality control coach in 2002, when the club won Super Bowl XXXVII.
- In 10 seasons in Tampa Bay, the Buccaneers finished fifth in total defense five times, while leading the League in 2002 and 2005. He also helped the team finish as the top-rated pass defense three times (2002, 2004 & 2007).
- Morris began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant coach at Hofstra in 1998. He moved on to Cornell University as defensive backs coach and special teams assistant for the 1999 season. Morris served as defensive backs coach at Hofstra from 2000 to 2001 before joining the Buccaneers. He also held a defensive minority internship position with the New York Jets in the fall of 2001. Morris played safety at Hofstra from 1994-97 and received his Bachelor of Science degree in physical education. He is an Irvington, N.J. native.
