

BUCCANEERS TEAM

- Quarterback Tom Brady and tight end Rob Gronkowski have connected for 78 touchdowns in the regular season and need 1 more to match Dan Marino and Mark Clayton (79) for the fourthmost touchdown connections in NFL history.
- The Buccaneers defense held the Saints to 2.4 yards per carry in Week 1. If Tampa Bay holds Carolina to under 2.5 yards per carry, it will mark only the fifth time in franchise history that the team has held consecutive opponents under 2.5 yards per carry (last, 11/11/01 at Detroit 11/18/01 vs. Chicago).

TOM BRADY

- Brady has 543 regular season passing touchdowns and needs six to tie Drew Brees (549 - active) for the most regular season passing touchdowns in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has thrown for 616 touchdowns, the most in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Brady has 219 regular season wins, the secondmost by a playerin NFL history, trailing only Adam Vinatieri (221).
- Brady has two career regular season games with at least six passing touchdowns and needs one more such game to tie Peyton Manning (three) with the most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has seven such games, tied with Ben Roethlisberger for the third-most in NFL history.
- Brady has six career regular season games with at least five passing touchdowns and needs one more such game to pass Dan Marino (six) and Roethlisberger (six) for the third-most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady is tied with Manning with three such games.
- Brady has 29 career regular season games with at least four passing touchdowns and needs six more such games to pass Peyton Manning (35) for the second-most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has 30 such games and need four more to tie Manning (34) for the second-most such games in NFL history.
- Brady has 92 career regular season games with at least 300 passing yards and needs one more such game to tie Peyton Manning (93) for the second-most such games in NFL history. Including the postseason, Brady has 108 games with at least 300 passing yards, trailing only Drew Brees (128).

SHAQUIL BARRETT

- Barrett recorded a franchise-record 19.5 sacks in 2019. With 15.0 or more sacks in 2020, he would be just the 11th player in NFL history to post consecutive seasons with at least 15.0 sacks.
- Barrett has 19.5 sacks as a Buccaneer. He needs 6.5 more to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for 10th-most sacks in franchise history.



CAMERON BRATE

- Brate has 27 career touchdown catches. He needs one more to pass Mark Carrier (27 from 1987-92) and tie Joey Galloway (28 from 2004-08) for the fourth-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Brate has three career games with multiple touchdown receptions. He needs one more to tie Jimmie Giles for the most ever such games by a Buccaneers tight end and tie for the third-most such games in franchise history.

LAVONTE DAVID

- David has started 122 career games for Tampa Bay. With one more start, David will tie Gerald McCoy (213) for the eighth-most starts in franchise history.
- David has 22.5 career sacks. He needs 3.5 more to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for 10th-most and 4.0 more to pass Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history. Thomas holds the record for the most sacks by a linebacker in franchise history.
- David has 1,017 career tackles and needs 11 more to tie Hardy Nickerson for the third-most in franchise history (1,028).
- David has three career defensive touchdowns and needs one more to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).



MIKE EVANS

each of his first six seasons and, with 1,000 or more receiving yards in 2020, will become the only player in NFL history to record 1,000 or more receiving yards in each of their first seven seasons. Evans would extend his team record for 1,000-yard receiving seasons and consecutive 1,000 yard receiving seasons. He would tie Lance Alworth (1963-69), Brandon Marshall (2007-13), Jimmy Smith (1996-2002) and Reggie Wayne (2004-10) for the sixth-longest streak of 1,000-yard receiving seasons.

CHRIS GODWIN

- Godwin has 2,779 career receiving yards. He needs 169 more to pass Mike Williams (2,947 from 2010-13) for 10th-most receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has 17 career touchdown receptions.
 He needs three more to tie Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.
- Godwin had 1,333 receiving yards in 2019. If he surpasses 1,300 yards receiving in 2020, he would be the first player in team history to record 1,300-or-more yards in consecutive seasons.

ROB GRONKOWSKI

- Gronkowski has 7,872 regular season receiving yards and needs 37 more to pass Jimmy Graham (7,908 active) for the fifth-most receiving yards by a tight end in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has 9,035 receiving yards and needs 65 more to pass Greg Olson (9,099 active) for the fourth-most receiving yards by a tight end in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Gronkowski has 79 regular season receiving touchdowns. He needs one more to pass Harold Carmichael (79) and Charley Taylor (79) for 27th-most, two more to tie Art Powell and Steve Smith (81) for 25th-most and three more to tie Anquan Boldin and Reggie Wayne (82) for the 23rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has 91 receiving touchdowns and needs one more to pass Reggie Wayne (91) for the 14th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Gronkowski has 604 career receptions (regular season and postseason combined) and needs six more to tie Vernon Davis (610) for the seventh-most receptions by a tight end in NFL history.



LESEAN MCCOY

- McCoy has 11,071 career rushing yards. He needs 166 more to pass O.J. Simpson (11,236) for 21stmost and 171 more to pass Corey Dillon (11,241) for the 20th-most regular season rushing yards in NFL history.
- McCoy has 73 career rushing touchdowns. He needs one more to tie Earl Campbell and Leroy Kelly (74) for 26th-most, two more to tie Clinton Portis (75) for 25th-most and three more to tie Pete Johnson (76) for the 24th-most regular season rushing touchdowns in NFL history.
- McCoy has 14,870 career yards from scrimmage. He needs 22 more to pass Ricky Watters (14,891) for 26th-most, 242 more to pass Jerome Bettis (15,111) for 25th-most, 248 more to pass Steve Smith (15,118) for 24th-most, 251 more to pass Steven Jackson (15,121) for 23rd-most, 254 more to pass Tim Brown (15,124) for 22nd-most and 272 more to pass Tony Gonzalez (15,141) for the 21st-most regular season yards from scrimmage in NFL history.

JASON PIERRE-PAUL

Pierre-Paul has 22.0 sacks as a Buccaneer. He needs 4.0 more to tie Greg Spires (26.0 from 2002-07) for 10th-most and 4.5 more to tie Broderick Thomas (26.5 from 1989-93) for ninth-most in franchise history.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

MATT RHULE



The Carolina Panthers announced Matt Rhule as the franchise's fifth head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2020.

Rhule, 44, joins Carolina after three seasons (2017–19) as the head coach at Baylor University. Rhule helped rebuild the Baylor program, guiding the team from a 1–11 finish in his first season to a 7–6 record and a bowl berth in 2018 to an 11–3 record and appearance in the Big 12 Championship and the Sugar Bowl in 2019. This fall, he was voted the Chuck Neinas Coach of the Year by his peers.

His performance at Baylor continued a head coaching career that saw him turn around college programs' fortunes and guide teams to success. In his head coaching debut at Temple, (2013-16), Rhule took the Owls from a 2-10 mark in his first season to a 6-6 record in 2014 and two consecutive 10-win seasons in 2015 and 2016. Rhule has spent 22 years as a coach in the college and NFL ranks.

Baylor's appearance in the Sugar Bowl this season was just the second-ever in school history, and under Rhule's leadership the Bears became the first Power 5 program to go from 11 losses (2017) to 11 wins (2019) within two seasons.

Since 2016, Rhule has had 11 players selected in the NFL Draft, including the 2017 first round pick of the Arizona Cardinals Haason Reddick and Hurd, a 2019 third round selection by San Francisco. A total of 33 players have earned NFL opportunities in Rhule's first six seasons as a head coach.

In his time as a coach and player, Rhule's teams have played in 10 bowl games, including four times as a head coach. In his first season at Baylor, quarterback Charlie Brewer was named the 2017 Big 12 Co-Offensive Freshman of the Year.

Rhule came to Baylor after four seasons as head coach at Temple University. He guided the Owls to the school's first back-to-back 10-win seasons, a pair of bowl berths (2015–16), and the 2016 American Athletic Conference championship. He helped the Owls improve from a two-win season in his first year at the school in 2013.

Rhule returned to Temple after coaching with the New York Giants under head coach Tom Coughlin in 2012. He worked closely with Pat Flaherty in coaching the offensive line. The Giants finished 9-7 and averaged 335 yards on offense, with offensive guard Chris Snee earning 2012 Pro Bowl honors.

Prior to his stint in the NFL, Rhule spent six seasons as an assistant at Temple under head coaches Al Golden and Steve Addazio. He spent four seasons as offensive coordinator from 2008–11, coached quarterbacks and served as recruiting coordinator in 2007, and mentored the defensive line in 2006.

From 2002-05, Rhule was an assistant at Western Carolina, serving as assistant head coach during his last three seasons. He also was part of the staffs at UCLA (2001), Buffalo (1999-2000) and Albright College (1998)

A native of New York City, Rhule played linebacker at Penn State from 1994-97. He holds a master's degree from Buffalo. Rhule and his wife Julie have three children, Bryant, Vivienne and Leona.
