· Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). Brady currently ranks first in



the NFL in passing touchdowns and second in passing yards.



In 2012, he led the team to a 9-3 record, which remains the most wins by an interim head coach in NFL history.

- Buccaneers Quarterbacks Coach Clyde
 Christensen was a member of the Colts coaching staff in multiple roles from 2002-15.



TURN BACK THE CLOCK



Tampa Bay Buccaneers
Head Coach **Bruce Arians**took over as interim head
coach for the Indianapolis
Colts in 2012, filling in for
former Colts Head Coach
Chuck Pagano.

During Arians' run as interim head coach, the Colts went 9-3, the most wins by an interim head coach in NFL history. Arians was rewarded with his first NFL head coaching job the following season in Arizona.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

FRANK REICH



Frank Reich is in his fourth season as head coach of the Indianapolis Colts, having been named head coach on February 11, 2018.

Reich has 29 years of NFL experience both as a player (1985-1998) and a coach (2006-Present). He previously spent six years on the Indianapolis coaching staff from 2006-2011.

Reich has led the Colts to the playoffs in two of his first three seasons at the helm, including two years with 10-plus wins.

FRANK REICH AT A GLANCE

- Last season, Reich led one of the NFL's youngest teams to an 11-5 record and a playoff berth. The Colts were one of just four teams to finish in the top 10 in both overall defense (eighth) and offense (10th) in 2020.
- The Colts have finished in the top 10 in run defense in three consecutive seasons under Reich, marking the first time the team has accomplished that feat since 1975–77.
- During his first season as head coach in 2018, the Colts began the season 1-5 before winning nine of their last 10 games to become just the third team in NFL history to start a season 1-5 and make it to the playoffs. The 2018 Colts were only the second team in league history to win a playoff game after starting 1-5.
- He is one of three coaches in Colts history to win a playoff game in his first season and was named the AFC Coach of the Year in 2018 by the NFL 101 Awards.
- Reich spent the 2016-17 seasons as offensive coordinator for the Philadelphia Eagles, playing an instrumental role in the team's Super Bowl LII championship season.
- Reich assisted with the development of 2016 first round (No. 2 overall) pick Carson Wentz in Philadelphia before reuniting with Wentz in Indianapolis.
- Prior to Philadelphia, Reich spent three seasons with the San Diego Chargers from 2013-15, working closely with Philip Rivers.
- He spent his first six seasons as an assistant coach with the Colts from 2006-11 before coaching one year in Arizona (2012).
- Reich enjoyed a 14-year playing career with the Buffalo Bills, Carolina Panthers, New York Jets and Detroit Lions after being selected by the Bills in the third round (No. 57 overall) of the 1985 NFL Draft.
- Including postseason, Reich played in 129 career games, making 22 starts, completing 575-of-1,036 passes for 6,858 yards and 47 touchdowns.
- A native of Freeport, N.Y., Reich attended Cedar Crest High School in Lebanon, Pa., before playing collegiately at Marlyand.
