## **ACCOUNTABLE TO ONE ANOTHER**

The Buccaneers have the third-highest percentage of homegrown players on their 2023 roster, with 72.7% of the team composed of players who were either drafted or originally signed as an undrafted free agent by Tampa Bay, per OvertheCap.com.

During Tampa Bay's 2-0 start, 20 of the 24 total starters have been homegrown players.

## A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



· Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1.000 vards each.

· Dating back to the 2022 season, Chris Godwin has put forth 16 consecutive regular season games with five-or-more receptions, surpassing Keyshawn Johnson (15) for the franchise record.



· Godwin's is the longest active streak in the NFL

## **SOLID UP FRONT**

· Since the arrival of All-Pro tackle Tristan Wirfs in 2020, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.0%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (17). So far in 2023, the Buccaneers have allowed just one sack through Week 2 (68 pass attempts).

## THRIVING ON THIRD DOWNS

- · Baker Mayfield is leading the league through Week 2 in completion percentage on third-down attempts (87.0%). He also ranks second in passer rating on third down plays (132.1).
- · Mayfield also ranks fifth in overall passer rating (104.4), as well, completing 47-of-68 attempts for 490 yards and three touchdowns,

with no turnovers through Week 2.

· In Week 2, Mike Evans hauled in six receptions for 171 yards and one touchdown. His 28.5 yards per reception were his most in a game (minimum three receptions) since 12/16/18 at Baltimore (30.3).



· Evans' 91 yards after catch rank fourth among

wide receivers in 2023, while his five receptions of 20-or-more yards rank tied for third in the league.

## RE-EMPHASIZING THE RUN STOPPING



- $\cdot$  The Buccaneers defense put a priority on stopping the run and it has shown in the team's 2-0 start to the season, as Tampa Bay has allowed just 108 yards rushing on 33 carries (3.3 avg.).
- · In addition, the average distance of first contact with the opponent's rusher has come within a half-yard of the line of scrimmage the third-lowest yards before contact per rush average in the NFL through Week 2.

## TALLY UP THE TAKEAWAYS



· The Buccaneers defense has five takeaways through Week 2 and has been one of the league's best at creating turnovers since **Todd Bowles** took over the defense in 2019. From the start of the 2019 season, Tampa Bay ranks fifth in takeaways and first in points off turnovers.

## STEPPING UP IN THE SECONDARY



- · Antoine Winfield Jr. recorded a sack, forced fumble and a fumble recovery in Tampa Bay's Week 1 win over his father's former team, the Minnesota Vikings.
- **Winfield Jr.** is the only defensive back since at least 2000 with 10+ sacks, five-or-more forced

fumbles and five-or-more fumble recoveries in their first four career seasons. His 10.0 sacks since entering the league in 2020 are the most by a defensive back in the NFL during that span.

- **Winfield Jr.** is the first defensive back with a sack, forced fumble and fumble recovery in the same game since Jamal Adams in 2019 and the only DB to do so for Tampa Bay since at least 2000.
- · In his NFL debut, undrafted rookie defensive back **Christian Izien** picked off Kirk Cousins on the goal line to record his first career interception. Izien is the first Buccaneers player since 2010 to record an interception in his first career game, and just the fourth to do so in franchise history (excludes 1987 replacement players).
- **Izien** recorded a second interception in Week 2 becoming just the fourth undrafted player in league history with interceptions in each of his first two career games (Ray Isom, Robert Lester, Brenard Wilson).






## **MIKE EVANS**

- Needs 5 receptions to become the 59th player in NFL history, and first in team history, with 700 career receptions.
- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to tie Mark Clayton, Tommy McDonald, Irving Fryar and Andre Rison (84) for the 21st-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 2 receiving touchdowns to tie Lance Alworth, Jimmy Graham, Hines Ward and Paul Warfield (85) for the 17th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 3 receiving touchdowns to move into 17th place alone in all-time receiving touchdowns.
- Needs 55 receiving yards to surpass Stanley Morgan (10,716) for the 42nd-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs 195 receiving yards to surpass Gary Clark (10,856) for the 41st-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs 202 receiving yards to surpass Roddy White (10,863) for the 41st-most receiving yards in NFL history.

## **CHRIS GODWIN**

- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to tie Cameron Brate (33) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs 2 receiving touchdowns to tie Jimmie Giles (34) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs 1 touchdown to tie Jimmie Giles (34) for the fourth-most touchdowns from scrimmage in franchise history.
- Needs 5 receptions to tie Davante Adams, Pierre Garcon, Herman Moore and Jerry Rice (17) for the 9th-longest such streak in NFL history.
- Needs 5 receptions and 50 receiving yards to tie four players (11) for the 13th-longest such streak in NFL history.





## **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

- The **team** needs **a win** to start 3-0 for the fifth time in franchise history, and the first time since 2005.
- CB **Christian Izien** needs **1 interception** to become the first undrafted player in NFL history with an interception in each of his first three career games and just the fifth player to do so overall, joining John Anderson (1978), Terry Jackson (1978), Paul Krause (1970) and Carl Lockhart (1970).

- X Named 2014 Assistant Coach of the Year by the Pro Football Writers Association and the Associated Press.
- X The architect of Tampa Bay's Super Bowl LV-winning defense during the 2020 NFL
- X Bowles' defenses have finished inside the top five in fewest yards per play five times (2013, 2015, 2019, 2020, 2021).
- X Placing a heavy emphasis on stopping the run, Bowles' defenses have led the NFL in fewest rushing yards allowed per game three times (2014, 2019, 2020).
- X 24 different players have earned Pro Bowl selections with Bowles as their position coach, defensive coordinator or head coach.
- X Enjoyed an eight-year career as an NFL defensive back, playing for Washington (1986-1990, 1992-93) and the San Francisco 49ers.

## **AMPA BAY BUCCANEERS**

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached six different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021) and Tristan Wirfs (2022).
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-toback seasons from 2019-20.
- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing vards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defensed (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

## NICK SIRIANNI



Nick Sirianni entered his third season as head coach of the Philadelphia Eagles with a combined 23-11 record, which marks the most wins by any head coach in their first two years with the franchise. One of just two head coaches to start their Eagles career with back-to-back postseason berths, Sirianni directed a record-breaking 2022 campaign that resulted in an NFC East crown, conference title and appearance in Super Bowl LVII.

## **NICK SIRIANNI AT A GLANCE**

- In navigating Philadelphia to its fourth all-time trip to the Super Bowl in 2022, Sirianni established himself as the youngest head coach in Eagles history to reach the game's biggest stage. He also steered the team to the most regular-season victories (14) in franchise history. As a result of that success, Sirianni became the fourth NFL head coach to produce a 14-win campaign within their first two career years at the helm. He is the only head coach to accomplish that feat after taking over a team that produced a losing record the year before their arrival.
- Under Sirianni's guidance in 2022, Philadelphia cemented a number of other single-season team records, including points (477), total touchdowns (59), scrimmage touchdowns (57), rushing touchdowns (32, tied for fourth in NFL history), total first downs (385), third-down conversion rate (45.9 pct.), fourth-down conversions (22), red zone touchdown efficiency (67.8 pct.) as well as defensive sacks (70, tied for third in NFL history). The Eagles also finished among the top three teams in total offense (third, 389.1 ypg) and defense (second, 301.5 ypg) for the first time since the 1970 merger.
- Following the 2022 season, two of Sirianni's top lieutenants branched out to head coaching positions – defensive coordinator Jonathan Gannon (Cardinals) and offensive coordinator Shane Steichen (Colts), who was voted a finalist for the AP NFL Assistant Coach of the Year award.
- Prior to arriving in Philadelphia, Sirianni spent three years as the Indianapolis Colts' offensive coordinator (2018-20), following a five-year stint with the Los Angeles/San Diego Chargers (2013-17).
   He began his NFL coaching career with the Kansas City Chiefs (2009-12), serving as wide receivers coach (2012) and offensive quality control coach (2009-11).
- Before entering the NFL coaching ranks, Sirianni spent five years at the collegiate level as wide receivers coach at Indiana University of Pennsylvania (2006-08) and as defensive backs coach at Mount Union (2004-05), his alma mater, where he helped the Purple Raiders capture a national title during the 2005 season.
- A native of Jamestown, NY, Sirianni was a three-year starter at wide receiver at Mount Union (Alliance, OH), winning three NCAA Division III National Championships (2000-02) and earning All-Ohio Athletic Conference honors as a senior after catching a careerhigh 13 touchdowns. He also played one year in the Atlantic Indoor Football League with the Canton Legends while coaching in 2005.
- · Sirianni and his wife, Brett, have two sons, Jacob and Miles, and one daughter, Taylor.
