## THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). **Brady currently ranks first in the NFL in passing touchdowns and second in passing yards.**

• Godwin joined current teammates Cameron Brate and Mike Evans among the top five in team history with 28 career receiving touchdowns, while also recording his 14th career 100-yard receiving game, which is tied for the third-most in team history.

Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and currently ranking ninth in 2021.

# CONNECTIONS

## PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Buccaneers QB **Tom Brady** (2000-19) and TE **Rob Gronkowski** (2010-18) spent time in New England with multiple coaches on the New York staff, including Giants Head Coach **Joe Judge**, Assistant Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator **Patrick Graham** (2009-15) and Quarterbacks Coach **Jerry Schuplinski** (2013-18).
- Buccaneers P **Bradley Pinion** (2015-18) played for the San Francisco 49ers when Giants Special Teams Coordinator **Thomas McGaughey** held the same position in San Francisco in 2015.
- Buccaneers OLB **Jason Pierre-Paul** (2010-17) played under Giants Assistant Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator **Patrick Graham**, who previously worked as New York's defensive line coach from 2016-17.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2015-18) was the head coach for the New York Jets when the organization drafted Giants DL **Leonard Williams** (2015-19) with the sixth-overall pick in 2015. Williams played for multiple coaches on the Buccaneers staff, including defensive quality control coach **Tim Atkins**, inside linebackers coach **Mike Caldwell** and defensive line coach **Kacy Rodgers**.



## COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers Head Coach **Bruce Arians** (2013-17) was the head coach of the Arizona Cardinals when Giants Assistant Defensive Backs Coach **Anthony Blevins** (2013-17) was an assistant special teams coach, Giants Assistant Coach **Amos Jones** (2013-17) was the special teams coordinator and Giants Tight Ends Coach **Freddie Kitchens** (2007-16) held multiple roles for the Cardinals. Multiple coaches on the Tampa Bay coaching staff worked in Arizona during this time as well.
- Buccaneers Specialists Coach **Chris Boniol** was the assistant special teams coach for the Dallas Cowboys from 2010-13 when Giants Offensive Coordinator **Jason Garrett** was the head coach of the Cowboys (2011-19) and Giants Defensive Backs Coach **Jerome Henderson** (2012-15) held the same position in Dallas.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2005-07) was the defensive backs coach for the Dallas Cowboys when Giants Offensive Coordinator **Jason Garrett** was the offensive coordinator in Dallas in 2007.
- Buccaneers Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell** spent the 2002 season as a linebacker with the Philadelphia Eagles, playing with Giants Offensive Line Coach **Marc Colombo** (2002-05). The two were a part of an Eagles squad that advanced to the NFC Championship game before falling to the Buccaneers, 27-10.



# HC BRUCE ARIANS

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

## ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

## TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

## INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

# JOE JUDGE



Joe Judge was named the 19th head coach in New York Giants history on Jan. 8, 2020.

The Giants finished Judge's first season as head coach in second place in the NFC East at 6-10, their best record since they were 11-5 in 2016.

New York's 4-2 NFC East record was also their best since 2016, when they were 4-2. The Giants won all three divisional games at home in 2020, as well.

## JOE JUDGE AT A GLANCE

- Last season the Giants defense ranked 12th in the NFL, allowing 349.3 yards per game. It was the team's best defensive finish since 2016.
- New York's rush defense ranked 10th in the NFL in 2020, allowing 111.4 rush yards per game, which also was the team's best mark since 2016.
- Judge brought to his first head coaching job 15 years of experience including the last eight with the New England Patriots. In 2019, Judge was both the Patriots special teams coordinator and the team's wide receivers coach.
- He joined the Patriots in 2012 as the team's assistant special teams coach, a position he held for three years. He was then elevated to special teams coordinator in 2015 and was given the additional responsibility of coaching the wide receivers in 2019.
- In his 15 seasons as an NFL and collegiate coach, Judge has been a part of five championship teams. He was on the Patriots' staff when they won Super Bowls XLIX, LI and LIII. New England reached the playoffs in every one of Judge's eight seasons and played in the AFC Championship Game in each his first seven seasons with the team. In addition, he coached at the University of Alabama when the Crimson Tide won BCS titles in 2009 and 2011.
- Judge spent the previous 11 seasons working under two of the most successful coaches in football history in Nick Saban and Bill Belichick.
- Judge began his coaching career at his alma mater, Mississippi State, where he was a graduate assistant from 2005-07. He served as the special teams/linebackers coach at Birmingham-Southern in 2008. The following year, he began a three-year stint as a football analyst/special teams assistant under Saban at Alabama.
- Judge was born in Philadelphia, where his father, Joseph, played football at Temple and later with the Hamilton Tiger-cats of the CFL.
- Judge played at Mississippi State from 2000-04, earning three letters. He and his wife, Amber, a former Mississippi State soccer player, have four children - Sean, Michael, Emma Riley and Ella Grace.
