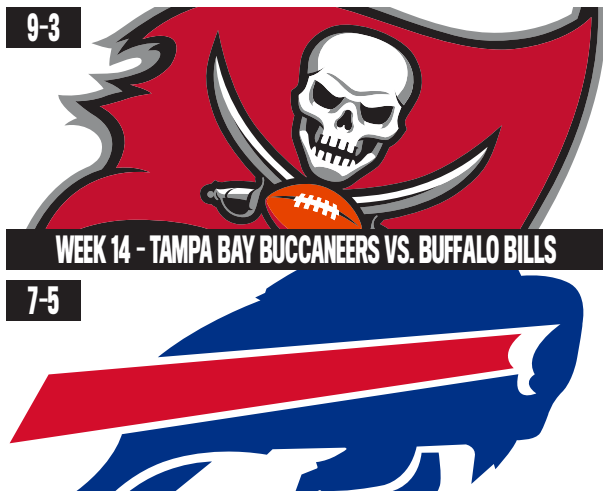

## THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). **Brady currently ranks first in the NFL in both passing touchdowns and passing yards.**

### TOP 10 DEFENSE

Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and currently ranking 10th in 2021.

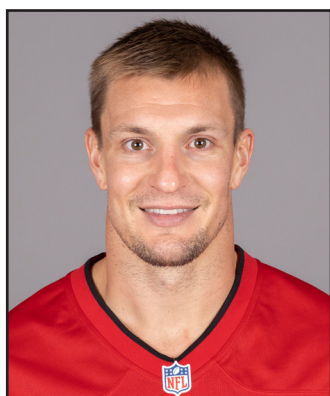

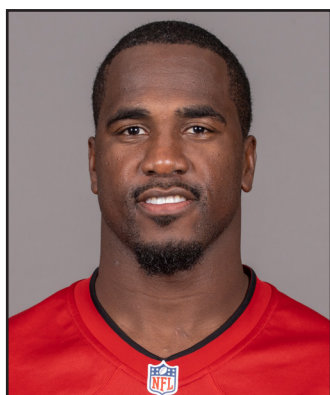

- Buccaneers QB **Tom Brady** (2000–19), TE **Rob Gronkowski** (2010–18), Bills Coaching Assistant **Leonard Johnson** (2015) and Assistant Offensive Lineman Coach **Ryan Wendell** (2008–15) played together for the New England Patriots.



## COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Bills Head Coach **Sean McDermott** held a variety of roles in Philadelphia from 1999–2010, working with Buccaneers Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell** (1998–2001, 2007–12) as both a coach and a player as well as Buccaneers General Manager **Jason Licht** who worked in the Eagles personnel department from 2003–07.
- Bills Offensive Coordinator **Brian Daboll** (2011) served as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins while Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2008–11) served as the secondary coach and interim head coach.
- Bills Special Teams Coordinator **Heath Farwell** (2005–2010) played under Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach **Kevin Ross** (2002–05), who served as the defensive backs coach for the Minnesota Vikings.
- Buccaneers Inside Linebackers Coach **Mike Caldwell** played under Bills Defensive Coordinator/Assistant Head Coach **Leslie Frazier** (1999–2002), who served as the defensive backs coach with the Philadelphia Eagles.
- Bills Assistant Defensive Line Coach **Jacques Cesaire** (2003–12) played under Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach **Kevin Ross** (2007–08) while with the San Diego Chargers.



# HC BRUCE ARIANS

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

## ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

## TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

## INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

# SEAN MCDERMOTT



Sean McDermott was named head coach of the Bills on January 11, 2017 after spending six seasons as the defensive coordinator of the Carolina Panthers.

McDermott has coached the Bills to three playoff appearances in his first four seasons for a franchise that had last experienced a postseason berth in 1999. He became just the third coach in Bills history to earn a playoff berth in his first season at the helm, joining Joe Collier (1966) and Wade Phillips (1998).

## SEAN MCDERMOTT AT A GLANCE

- In 2020, the Bills went 13-3 and captured their first division title and first playoff win since 1995. The 13 wins tied for the most in team history. McDermott finished second in NFL Coach of the Year voting and has been a finalist for that honor in each of the past two seasons.
- In 2019, Buffalo posted their first 10-win season since 1999.
- With 47 wins to date, including playoffs, McDermott ranks third in franchise history in coaching wins trailing only Marv Levy (123) and Lou Saban (70).
- During his six seasons as defensive coordinator in Carolina, McDermott led a top 10 defense four times and helped the Panthers earn three division titles and a trip to Super Bowl 50. Over his six-year tenure, the Panthers defense ranked second in sacks (261), third in takeaways (169), sixth in rushing yards allowed per game (103.3), ninth in yards per game (339.1) and 12th in points allowed per game (22.1).
- Prior to Carolina, McDermott spent his first 12 NFL seasons in Philadelphia in a variety of roles, working his way up to defensive coordinator in 2009-10.
- A member of the Williams & Mary Athletics Hall of Fame, McDermott was an All-Atlantic 10 Conference choice at safety in 1997 and graduated with a degree in finance. He was college teammates with Pittsburgh Steelers Head Coach Mike Tomlin.
- McDermott began his coaching career at his alma mater in 1998 as a graduate assistant.
- Sean and his wife, Jamie, have three children. Sean's father, Rich, was a football coach at West Chester and Ursinus and his brother, Tim, is the Chief Business Officer of the Philadelphia Union of the MLS.
- McDermott was born in Omaha Nebraska on March 21, 1974.
