· Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). Brady currently leads the NFL



with nine touchdown passes and ranks fifth in passing yards.

· With 1,006 yards in 2020, Mike Evans became the first player in NFL history with 1,000-or-more receiving yards in each of his first seven NFL seasons, surpassing Randy Moss (first six seasons).



· Evans set a new franchise record with 13 receiving

touchdowns (fourth in the NFL) and is Tampa Bay's all-time leader in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns.

Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020.

FORMER BUCCANEERS

- Rams K Matt Gay was drafted by the Buccaneers in the fifth round of the 2019 NFL Draft and played in all 16 games his rookie season.
- Rams WR **DeSean Jackson** played two seasons with the Buccaneers from 2017-18, recording 91 receptions for 1,442 yards (15.8 avg.) and seven touchdowns.
- Rams Head Coach **Sean McVay** began his NFL coaching career as an offensive assistant for the Buccaneers in 2008.
- Rams Defensive Coordinator Raheem Morris was a defensive quality control coach for Tampa Bay during Tampa Bay's Super Bowl XXXVII season. He was later promoted to defensive assistant (2003) and assistant defensive backs coach (2004-05). After a one-year stint at Kansas State, Morris returned to the Buccaneers as defensive backs coach (2007-08) and later head coach (2009-11).

 Buccaneers DL **Ndamukong Suh** played for the Rams in 2018, starting all 16 regular season games and helping the franchise win the NFC Championship and appear in Super Bowl LIII.

CONNECTIONS

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Buccaneers QB Tom Brady (2000-19) played alongside Rams Offensive Coordinator Kevin O'Connell in 2008 and with Rams Assistant Quarterbacks Coach Zac Robinson in 2010. Both Los Angeles coaches were drafted by New England and served as Brady's backups in New England.
- Buccaneers DL Ndamukong Suh (2010-14) played for the Detroit Lions when Rams Assistant Quarterbacks Coach Zac Robinson (2010) was a quarterback and Rams Director of Football Affairs Jacques McClendon was a center on the team from 2011-12. Suh and McClendon were also teammates for the Miami Dolphins from 2015-16.
- Buccaneers CB Sean Murphy-Bunting (2015-18)
 played collegiately at Central Michigan, where Rams
 Senior Coaching Assistant John Bonamego was the
 head coach from 2015-18.
- Buccaneers OLB Shaquil Barrett (2015-18) played for the Denver Broncos when Rams Assistant Linebackers Coach Thad Bogardus was a coaching intern and defensive coaching assistant in Denver (2015-16).



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers Special Teams Coordinator **Keith Armstrong** (2008-18) held the same position with the Atlanta Falcons when Rams General Manager **Les Snead** was a scout and director of pro personnel for the organization from 1997-2011. Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** spent the 2007 season in Atlanta while Snead was a scout for the organization, as well.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles (2005-07) was the defensive backs coach, Buccaneers Defensive Line Coach Kacy Rodgers held the same position (2003-07) and Buccaneers Specialists Coach Chris Boniol (2010-13) was the assistant special teams coach for the Dallas Cowboys when Rams Tight Ends Coach/Pass Game Coordinator Wes Phillips held multiple positions with the organization from 2007-13.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2008-11) was an assistant head coach/secondary coach and interim head coach and Buccaneers Defensive Line Coach **Kacy Rodgers** (2008-14) held the same position with the Miami Dolphins when Rams Senior Coaching Assistant **John Bonamego** also held the same position with Miami from 2008-10. Rams Offensive Coordinator **Kevin O'Connell** was a quarterback for the Dolphins in 2011 as well.
- Buccaneers Specialists Coach Chris Boniol (2010-13) coached alongside Rams Special Teams Coordinator Joe DeCamillis (2009-12) in Dallas.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

SEAN MCVAY



On January 12, 2017, Sean McVay was named the 23rd full-time head coach in franchise history. McVay became the youngest coach in modern NFL history at 30 years old.

During the 2020 season, McVay produced his fourth-straight winning season with the Rams, the longest consecutive winning season streak since the Rams posted four-consecutive winning seasons from 1983-1986. The 10-6 record earned L.A. its third postseason appearance in McVay's first four seasons leading the franchise.

SEAN MCVAY AT A GLANCE

- In 2020, the Rams defensive unit finished the season as the No. 1 ranked unit across the league, with Aaron Donald being named NFL Defensive Player of the Year. The Rams defense held opposing offenses to only 16.8 points per game. The Rams held opposing offenses to 281.9 yards per game, 190.7 passing yards per game and held each opposing quarterback to under 300 net yards passing. As a team, L.A. held opponents to only 18.5 points per game.
- In McVay's second season guiding the Rams in 2018, the 32-year-old leader turned in one of the best seasons in franchise history. The Rams posted a 13-3 record, which tied for the second-best record in franchise history, won a pair of playoff games and advanced to the Rams fourth Super Bowl appearance days after his 33rd birthday, becoming the youngest NFL head coach to ever help his team to a Super Bowl.
- The 2018 Los Angeles Rams built on the successful foundation McVay and company laid in their first season in 2017. With the guidance of McVay, the Rams' passing attack finished among the top-10 in passing yards per attempt (8.33, 4th), passing yards per game (295.6, 5th) and touchdowns (32, tied for 8th). The defense was led by DT Aaron Donald, who posted a franchise-best 20.5 sacks, the most ever by a defensive tackle. Donald recorded 183.5 sack yards, the most ever by a defender in a single season. As a unit, the Rams ranked sixth with 1.6 takeaways per game.
- In his first season guiding the Rams, McVay completed one of the greatest offensive turnarounds in NFL history. He helped the Rams move from the 32nd-ranked scoring offense in 2016 to the league's top-scoring team in 2017, marking the first time in league history a team has gone from last to first in scoring. The first-year head coach led the Rams to an 11-5 record and their first NFC West title since the 2003 season, earning the team's first playoff berth since 2004.
- Before joining the Rams, McVay completed his third season as the Redskins' offensive coordinator in 2016 after initially being promoted to the position on January 15, 2014. Prior to his promotion during the 2014 offseason, McVay spent three seasons as the team's tight ends coach (2011-13) and one as an offensive assistant (2010).
- McVay joined the Redskins prior to the 2010 season after an undefeated regular season with the Florida Tuskers of the United Football League (UFL). McVay originally entered the National Football League as an offensive assistant with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 2008.
- McVay graduated from Miami University (Ohio) where he played wide receiver from 2004-07, earning Miami's Scholar- Athlete Award in 2007.
