THE BUZZ AROUND BOWLES' DEFENSE



NO. 27 TO NO. 6

Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and currently ranking ninth in 2021.





- Saints OB Jameis Winston was the No. 1 overall selection in the 2015 NFL Draft by the Buccaneers. He played five seasons with Tampa Bay and stands as the franchise's all-time leader in both passing yards (19,737) and passing touchdowns (121).
- Saints LB Kwon Alexander was a fourth-round selection (No. 124 overall) by the Buccaneers in the 2015 NFL Draft. He played four seasons in Tampa Bay, earning one Pro Bowl selection in 2017.

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- When Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd**Bowles (2015-18) was the head coach of the New
 York Jets, he helped Saints LB **Demario Davis**record the best season of his career during the
 2017 campaign. Davis, who finished the season
 with career-best outputs in sacks (5.0), tackles
 (135), tackles for loss (13) and quarterback hits
 (15), also worked with a pair of current Buccaneer
 coaches who were on the defensive side of the
 ball in New York **Mike Caldwell** and **Kacy Rodgers**. Davis led the New York defense in sacks,
 tackles and tackles for loss, while finishing with the
 second-most quarterback hits.
- CB Richard Sherman (2011-17) played under Saints Secondary Coach Kris Richard (2012-17) who served as the defensive backs coach and defensive coordinator for the Seattle Seahawks.
- Buccaneers LB Kevin Minter played at LSU from 2009-12 alongside Saints Assistant to the Head Coach/Offensive Assistant Kevin Petry.
- Buccaneers T Tristan Wirfs played at Iowa from 2016-18 when Saints Offensive Assistant Declan Doyle served in a similar role for the Hawkeyes.



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Saints Head Coach **Sean Payton** spent the 2003-05 seasons as the assistant head coach & quarterbacks coach in Dallas, while Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** (2005-07) and Defensive Line Coach **Kacy Rodgers** (2003-07) were on the staff.
- Buccaneers Specialists Coach Chris Boniol worked as the assistant special teams coach in Oakland in 2014, when Saints Defensive Coordinator Dennis Allen was the head coach.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles and defensive line coach Kacy Rodgers coached alongside Special Teams Coordinator Darren Rizzi with the Miami Dolphins from 2010-11. Rodgers and Rizzi were both on Miami's staff together from 2008-14.
- Buccaneers Quarterbacks Coach **Clyde Christensen** was on the Miami Dolphins staff when Saints Special Teams Coordinator **Darren Rizzi** coached in Miami from 2016-18. Saints Assistant Special Teams Coach **Phil Galiano** was a special teams intern for Miami in 2016.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

Since he was hired as head coach of the New Orleans Saints in 2006, Sean Payton has established himself as one of the most successful coaches in the NFL. Since coming to New Orleans, Payton has led the Saints to nine playoff berths, seven NFC South division titles and the franchise's first World Championship with a 31–17 win over the Indianapolis Colts in Super Bowl XLIV.

Payton is the longest-tenured coach within the NFC and the second-longest tenured coach in all of football, trailing only New England's Bill Belichick.

SEAN PAYTON AT A GLANCE

- Payton has presided over the NFL's most prolific offense since his arrival, leading the league in net yards per game in 2006, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2014 and 2016 and finishing first in scoring in 2008 and 2009.
- Payton and the Saints' success continued in 2020 when they won the NFC South for the fourth-straight season, posting a 12-4 record. They became the only team since the start of the NFC South in 2002 to capture four-straight division titles. The Saints' regular season marks the last four seasons are 11-5, 13-3, 13-3 and 12-4, their first stretch of four consecutive winning campaigns. The division title was the franchise's ninth since 1991, the seventh under Payton's leadership. It was the seventh time in franchise history and fifth under Payton that the Saints finished a season with at least 12 wins. The Saints advanced to postseason play for the fourth consecutive season, the first time they accomplished the feat in the franchise's 54-season history.
- Payton was hired after serving as a member of the Dallas Cowboys coaching staff from 2003-05 under Pro Football Hall of Fame inductee Bill Parcells. Prior to his final season with the Cowboys, Payton was promoted to assistant head coach/passing game coordinator and was responsible for the team's play-calling after serving as assistant head coach/quarterbacks from 2003-04.
- Payton went to Dallas following four years with the New York Giants (1999-2002), the last three as offensive coordinator after spending his first season as quarterbacks coach.
- Payton wrapped two coaching stints at San Diego State
 University (1988-89 and 1992-93) around a stop at Indiana State
 (1990-91). During his second stretch with the Aztecs, Payton was
 running backs coach, working with Heisman Trophy runner-up
 Marshall Faulk before becoming quarterbacks coach.
- Following the 1993 season, Payton moved to Miami (Ohio) (1994-95) where he was quarterbacks coach. He spent 1996 as quarterbacks coach at Illinois before entering the NFL.
- Payton earned his degree at Eastern Illinois, where as a quarterback he had 10,665 passing yards, then the third-highest total in NCAA Division I-AA history. The three-time AP All-American selection had professional stints with Chicago of the AFL, Ottawa of the CFL and the Chicago Bears in 1987. Payton was inducted into the Eastern Illinois Hall of Fame in 2000.
- Payton was born Dec. 29, 1963 in San Mateo, Calif., and raised in Naperville, Ill., Payton has a daughter, Meghan and a son, Connor.
