

### **SHAQUIL BARRETT**

 Barrett has 27.5 sacks as a Buccaneer. He needs 1.0 more to pass Rondé Barber (28.0 from 1997-2012) for the ninth-most sacks in franchise history.

#### **TOM BRADY**

- Brady has 30 passing touchdowns this season.
  He needs three more to tie Winston (33 in 2019) for
  the most passing touchdowns in a single season in
  Buccaneers history.
- Brady has 3,496 passing yards this season. He needs nine more to pass Jameis Winston (3,504 in 2017) for ninth-most, 59 more to pass Steve DeBerg (3,554 in 1984) for eighth-most, 68 more to pass Doug Williams (3,563 in 1981) for seventh-most, 97 more to pass Josh Freeman (3,592 in 2011) sixth-most and 316 more to pass Brad Johnson (3,811 in 2003) for the fifth-most passing yards in a single season in Buccaneers history.



### **CAMERON BRATE**

- Brate has 29 career touchdown catches. He needs two more to tie Kevin House (31 from 1980-86) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Brate has 216 career receptions. He needs two more to tie Kellen Winslow (218 from 2009-11) for the second-most receptions by a tight end in team history.


### **ANTONIO BROWN**

- Brown has 11,431 career receiving yards, the 32nd-most in NFL history. He needs 140 more to pass Calvin Johnson (11,619 from 2007-2015) for the 31st-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Brown has 75 career touchdown receptions, tied for the 35th-most in NFL history. He needs one more to pass James Lofton (75 from 1978-1993) and tie Fred Biletnikoff (76 from 1965-1978) and Harold Jackson (76 from 1968-1983) for the 33rd-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.



### **LAVONTE DAVID**

- David has 24.0 career sacks. He needs 3.5 more to tie Shaquil Barrett (27.5 from 2019-Present) for the 10th-most sacks in franchise history.
- David has three career defensive touchdowns and needs one more to tie for the third-most in franchise history (David Logan, 1979-96; Mike Washington, 1976-84).



### **CHRIS GODWIN**

- Godwin has 3,287 career receiving yards, the 10th-most in franchise history. He needs 157 more to pass Gerald Carter (3,443 from 1981-87) for the ninthmost receiving yards in franchise history.
- Godwin has 20 career touchdown receptions. He needs one more to pass Vincent Jackson (20 from 2012-16) for the 10th-most receiving touchdowns in Buccaneers history.

### WHAT TO WATCH FOR

### **MIKE EVANS**

- Evans has 11 receiving touchdowns this season.
   He needs one more to tie his own mark (12 in 2014 & 2016) for the most receiving touchdowns in a single season in Buccaneers history.
- Evans has 7,929 career receiving yards and 59 career receiving touchdowns. He needs 71 yards and one touchdown to join Larry Fitzgerald, Marvin Harrison, Calvin Johnson, Randy Moss, Jerry Rice and Sterling Sharpe as the only players in NFL history with at least 8,000 receiving yards and 60 receiving touchdowns in their first seven seasons.

### **ROB GRONKOWSKI**

- Gronkowski has 84 regular season receiving touchdowns, tied for the 18th-most in NFL history. He needs one more to pass Mark Clayton, Irving Fryar, Tommy McDonald and Andre Rison (84) and tie Lance Alworth, Paul Warfield and Hines Ward (85) for the 15th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history. Including the postseason, Gronkowski has 96 receiving touchdowns and needs one more to pass Andre Reed (96) for the 12th-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history (regular season and postseason combined).
- Gronkowski has 507 receiving yards this season and needs 73 more to pass Jimmie Giles for 10thmost (579 in 1979), 85 more to pass Cameron Brate (591 in 2017) for ninth-most and 96 more to pass Giles (602 in 1980) for the eighth-most receiving yards in a season by a Buccaneers tight end.



### **JASON PIERRE-PAUL**

- Pierre-Paul has **30.5 sacks** as a Buccaneer. He needs **2.5 more** to tie Brad Culpepper (33.0 from 1994-99) for seventh-most in franchise history.
- Pierre-Paul has 9.5 sacks this season. He needs
   2.5 more to tie Simeon Rice (12.0 in 2004) for the
   10th-most in a single season in franchise history.



### **RYAN SUCCOP**

 Succop has contributed 110 points this season. He needs eight more to tie Matt Bryan (118 in 2007) for the sixth-most points in a single season in franchise history.

### **BUCCANEERS TEAM**

- The Buccaneers recorded six sacks against the Vikings. With at least six sacks at Atlanta, it would mark only the second time in team history that Tampa Bay has posted consecutive games of six-or-more sacks (also 10/9/2000 at Minnesota-10/19/2000 vs. Detroit).
- The Buccaneers have scored 370 points this season, the fifth-most in a single season in team history. They need 19 more to pass 2000 (388) and tie 2012 (389) for third-most and 26 more to tie 2018 (396) for the second-most points in a single season in team history.
- The Buccaneers have 40.0 sacks this season, tied for the ninth-most in a single season in team history. They need two more to tie 1983 and 2001 (42.0) for seventh-most, three more to tie 1999 and 2002 (43.0) for fifth-most, four more to tie 1997 (44.0) for fourth-most, five more to tie 2004 (45.0) for third-most and seven more to tie 2019 (47.0) for the second-most sacks in a single season in team history.

### **TURN BACK THE CLOCK**

A pair of former Buccaneers head coaches will square off against their old team on Sunday as Falcons Interim Head Coach **Raheem Morris** was the head coach in Tampa Bay from 2009-11 after spending the 2007-08 seasons as the defensive backs coach. Morris also worked for the Buccaneers earlier in his coaching career, holding multiple defensive coaching positions from 2002-05. Additionally, Falcons Offensive Coordinator **Dirk Koetter** was the head coach of the Buccaneers from 2016-18 after spending a season as the offensive coordinator.

### PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Buccaneers Wide Receivers Coach Kevin Garver spent five seasons as a student assistant at Alabama from 2007-11. While there, Garver worked with Falcons WR Julio Jones, who was a star receiver in Tuscaloosa from 2008-10. During that three-season span, the Crimson Tide won 36 games, including a perfect 14-0 mark and BCS Championship in 2009. Alabama was ranked as high as No. 1 in all three seasons both Garver and Jones were together.
- Buccaneers DL Rakeem Nunez-Roches (2015-17) played for the Kansas City Chiefs when Falcons Defensive Analyst Bob Sutton (2013-18) was the defensive coordinator in Kansas City.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles (2015-18) was the head coach of the New York Jets when Falcons G James Carpenter (2015-18) played and started 58 games and Falcons OLB Edmond Robinson (2017) played for New York.
- Buccaneers Offensive Quality Control Coach
   John Van Dam was an Offensive Quality Control/
   Assistant Quarterbacks at Florida in 2015 when
   Falcons WR Brandon Powell (2014-17) played for
   the Gators.

- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** (2009) and Buccaneers Defensive/Special Teams Assistant **Cody Grimm** (2010-12) played for the Buccaneers when Falcons Interim Head Coach **Raheem Morris** was the head coach in Tampa Bay.
- Buccaneers General Manager Jason Licht held multiple positions with the Miami Dolphins from 1995-96, including offensive assistant/quality control coach. While Licht was there, Falcons Running Backs Coach Bernie Parmalee (1992-98) was a running back for the Dolphins.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles was a defensive backs coach with the New York Jets in 2000 when Falcons Defensive Analyst Bob Sutton was a linebackers coach in New York.
- Buccaneers Defensive Quality Control Coach **Tim Atkins** was a
  defensive assistant with the Miami Dolphins in 2007 when Falcons
  Defensive Safeties Coach **Chad Walker** (2005-07) was a defensive
  quality control coach and Falcons Defensive Assistant **Lance Schulters** was a safety in Miami.
- Buccaneers Special Teams Coordinator Keith Armstrong held the same position with the Miami Dolphins from 2001-07 and worked with Falcons Running Backs Coach Bernie Parmalee, who was a tight ends/special teams coach in Miami from 2002-04.
- Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles was a safety for the Washington Football Team from 1992-93 when Falcons Offensive Line Assistant Bob Kronenberg played for the organization as well.
- Buccaneers Offensive Line Coach Joe Gilbert held the same position at the University of Illinois in 2009 when Falcons Offensive Assistant Danny Breyer was a student assistant for the Illini.



### HC BRUCE ARIANS

### **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS**

- X Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

### **ARIZONA CARDINALS**

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.

### TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2019.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The team's seven wins were its most since 2016. In addition, the Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X Under Arians' direction, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense at 302.8 yards per game and ranking third in the NFL in total offense at 397.9 yards per game. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

### **INDIANAPOLIS COLTS**

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

Raheem Morris entered the season as the defensive coordinator for the Atlanta Falcons and was promoted to interim head coach on October 12, 2020. Since his promotion to interim head coach, Morris has led the Falcons to a 4-3 record (.571).

A veteran coach with 18 years of NFL coaching experience on both the offensive and defensive sides of the ball, Morris is in his sixth season with the Falcons and his first as the defensive coordinator/interim head coach.

### RAHEEM MORRIS AT A GLANCE

- Morris began the 2019 season focused on the receiving corps but turned his attention to the secondary after the bye week following a tumultuous start. Over the final eight games, the team went 6-2 and the defense went from having the lowest amount of takeaways in the first half of the season (4) to finishing with the second-most in the NFL (16) after Week 9. The defense also vaulted from the bottom of the league rankings to the top 10 in sacks (32nd to 10th), scoring efficiency (32nd to 9th), and red zone efficiency (31st to 6th) over the final eight weeks of the season.
- Morris joined the Falcons after spending three seasons as the defensive backs coach for the Washington Football Team. In 2012, he helped Washington's defense finish tied for fifth in the NFL with 31 takeaways.
- Prior to arriving in Washington, Morris spent three seasons as the head coach of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers from 2009-2011. He was the league's youngest head coach in 2009 and in 2010, his team finished with a 10-6 record. The Buccaneers made their best turnaround in franchise history in 2010 after going 3-13 in 2009.
- Morris served in multiple capacities with the Buccaneers during two different stints with the team before he was promoted to head coach. He spent two seasons as the team's defensive backs coach from 2007-08, during which time the Buccaneers allowed only ranked second in the NFL allowing 170.5 passing yards per game. During that span, the Buccaneers ranked among the league leaders with 22 interceptions.
- Morris made his NFL coaching debut with Tampa Bay as a defensive quality control coach in 2002, when the club won Super Bowl XXXVII.
- In 10 seasons in Tampa Bay, the Buccaneers finished fifth in total defense five times, while leading the League in 2002 and 2005. He also helped the team finish as the top-rated pass defense three times (2002, 2004 & 2007).
- Morris began his collegiate coaching career an assistant coach at Hofstra in 1998. He moved on to Cornell University as defensive backs coach and special teams assistant for the 1999 season. Morris served as defensive backs coach at Hofstra from 2000 to 2001 before joining the Buccaneers. He also held a defensive minority internship position with the New York Jets in the fall of 2001. Morris played safety at Hofstra from 1994-97 and received his Bachelor of Science degree in physical education. He is an Irvington, N.J. native.
