DIALING IT UP DAVE'S WAY - CANALES TAKES CHARGE

Dave Canales takes over the Tampa Bay offense following his 13-year run with the Seattle Seahawks. In his most recent position as quarterbacks coach, Canales coached Geno Smith to his first career Pro Bowl selection and NFL Comeback Player of the Year honors. Smith led the league in completion percentage (69.8), while setting career highs in passing yards (4,282) and touchdowns (30).

· Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.

- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached six different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021) and Tristan Wirfs (2022).
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-toback seasons from 2019-20.

In his first season as head coach in 2022, Kevin O'Connell led the Vikings to 13 wins, the most by any first-year head coach in franchise history, earning the club's first division title since 2017. O'Connell had seven players win Player of the Week awards in 2022, the most by a first-year head coach in franchise history, seven notched Pro Bowl berths, and three earned Associated Press All-Pro honors.

Minnesota finished 11-0 in one-score games during the regular season after going 5-8 in those same situations in

2021. The team also had an NFL-record-tying 10 comeback wins this season, including overcoming a 33-point halftime deficit in Week 15 against the Colts, the greatest comeback in NFL history.

KEVIN O'CONNELL AT A GLANCE

- Several players excelled under O'Connell's direction in 2022. QB
 Kirk Cousins orchestrated eight fourth quarter comebacks this
 season, tied with Matthew Stafford (2016) for the NFL record. He
 also recorded eight game-winning drives on the season, which led
 the NFL. WR Justin Jefferson set the Vikings new single-season
 record for receiving yards (1,809) and receptions (128), passing Hall
 of Fame WRs Cris Carter (122 in 1994 and 1995) and Randy Moss
 (1,632 in 2003).
- The Vikings had two players combine for 10 interceptions in 2022 -CB Patrick Peterson (5) and S Harrison Smith (5) - marking the most by two Vikings teammates in a season since Antoine Winfield (4) and Darren Sharper (9) combined for 13 in 2005.
- O'Connell was named the 10th head coach in franchise history on Feb. 16, 2022, after serving as the offensive coordinator for the Los Angeles Rams (2020–21).
- In 2021, he led the Rams to finish ninth in total offense (372.1 yards per game) and helped his unit rank fourth in yards per play (5.98). Under the guidance of O'Connell, Rams QB Matthew Stafford and WR Cooper Kupp both had career years in 2021. Stafford set the single-season team record for passing yards (4,886) and tied Kurt Warner from his 1999 MVP season for the most passing touchdowns in a season by a Rams quarterback with 41, while also winning his first playoff game in his 13th season in the NFL. Kupp, who was named 2021 NFL Offensive Player of the Year by The Associated Press and Super Bowl LVI MVP, had one of the best receiving seasons in NFL history, leading the NFL in receptions (145), receiving yards (1,947) and receiving touchdowns (16), earning AP First-Team All-Pro and Pro Bowl honors.
- Prior to joining the Rams, O'Connell worked in Washington, serving as the quarterbacks coach (2017-18) and offensive coordinator (2019).
 O'Connell worked on special projects with the San Francisco 49ers in 2016 and was the quarterbacks coach in Cleveland in 2015.
- As a player, O'Connell was drafted in the third round (94th pick) of the 2008 NFL Draft by the New England Patriots out of San Diego State. The Carlsbad, California, native and his wife, Leah, have two sons, Kaden and Kolten, and two daughters, Quinn and Callie. O'Connell's father, Bill, was a longtime FBI agent, and his mother, Suzanne had a career as an educator. O'Connell has an older sister, Kelley, who is an attorney.


