Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and currently ranking seventh in 2021.





# CONNECTIONS

#### PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- The 2011 Detroit Lions who finished the season with a 10-6 record and advanced to the postseason for the first time since 1999 - featured two players who will be on opposing sidelines on Saturday: Buccaneers DL Ndamukong Suh and Washington Defensive Backs Coach Chris Harris.
- Buccaneers OLB Jason Pierre-Paul (2010-17)
   played for the New York Giants when Washington
   Assistant Defensive Line Coach Jeff Zagonia held
   the same position in New York for the 2016 season.
- Buccaneers QB Blaine Gabbert (2011-13) played for the Jacksonville Jaguars during Washington Defensive Coordinator Jack Del Rio's time as the head coach in Jacksonville from 2003-11.
- Buccaneers CB Ross Cockrell played under Washington Head Coach Ron Rivera when he played for the Carolina Panthers in 2019.



#### **COACHING CONNECTIONS**



- Two former coaches at Grambling State University will meet Sunday as Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator **Todd Bowles** and Washington Senior Vice President of Player Development **Doug Williams** reunite. Williams was the head coach at Grambling State from 1998-2003, hiring Bowles as his defensive coordinator from 1998-99. Williams and Bowles arrived at Grambling State together after spending one season in their same roles at Morehouse College in 1997.
- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** was selected 7th overall in the 2003 NFL Draft by the Jacksonville Jaguars. Leftwich played four seasons under Washington Defensive Coordinator **Jack Del Rio**, who was the head coach in Jacksonville from 2003-11.
- Buccaneers Cornerbacks Coach **Kevin Ross** (2007-08) was the assistant secondary/quality control coach with the San Diego Chargers when Washington Head Coach **Ron Rivera** (2008-10) was the defensive coordinator for the Chargers.
- Buccaneers Special Teams Coordinator **Keith Armstrong** (1997-2000) held the same position with the Chicago Bears when Washington Head Coach **Ron Rivera** (1997-98) was a defensive quality control coach in Chicago.
- Buccaneers Assistant Head Coach/Run Game Coordinator Harold Goodwin (2004-06) was the assistant offensive line coach with the Chicago Bears when Washington Head Coach Ron Rivera (2004-06) was the defensive coordinator for the Bears.



# HC BRUCE ARIANS

### **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS**

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

### **ARIZONA CARDINALS**

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

### TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

### **INDIANAPOLIS COLTS**

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

# • RON RIVERA



Ron Rivera is in his 25th season coaching in the NFL and his second as Washington's head coach in 2021. He was named the 30th head coach in franchise history on Jan. 1, 2020.

His first regular season in Washington concluded with an NFC East division title after his team won five of its last seven games to win the division and clinch a playoff berth.

Rivera has been to the playoffs five times during his head coaching career.

#### **RON RIVERA AT A GLANCE**

- Rivera previously served as the head coach of the Carolina Panthers for nine seasons, where he led the team to threestraight divisional titles and an appearance in Super Bowl 50.
- Rivera was twice recognized as the NFL Coach of the Year by the Associated Press in 2013 and in 2015.
- He inherited a 2-14 Carolina Panthers team as a rookie head coach in 2011 and helped the team to four playoff appearances from 2013-17, tied for the second-most playoff berths in the NFC over that six-year period. In that span, the Panthers recorded 58 wins, tied for the most in any six-year period of their franchise history and fifth-most in the NFL.
- In 2015, Carolina won its second NFC Championship in franchise history, third-consecutive NFC South division title and appeared in Super Bowl 50. Carolina finished the season with a franchise-best 17-2 record.
- Hired by the Panthers for his defensive expertise, Rivera did not disappoint as the Panthers put together five top-10 finishes in total defense in seven seasons from 2012-18.
- Rivera coached back-to-back Rookie of the Year award winners in Carolina with quarterback Cam Newton and linebacker Luke Kuechly.
- Rivera served as the defensive coordinator for the Chicago Bears (2004-06) and the San Diego Chargers (2008-2010) before arriving in Charlotte. The 2008 Chargers defense - led by Rivera finished as the league's top-ranked defense.
- In 23 seasons as a coach and nine as a player, he has been with teams that have reached the playoffs 20 times, including nine conference championships and three Super Bowls.
- Prior to becoming a coodinator, Rivera spent five seasons as the linebackers coach for the Philadelphia Eagles (1999-2003) and two seasons as the defensive quality control coach for the Chicago Bears.
- He played all nine of his NFL seasons at outside linebacker for the Chicago Bears - the team that selected him in the second round of the 1984 draft out of the University of California.
- Rivera and his wife, Stephanie, have two children, Christopher and Courtney. Stephanie is a former assistant coach for the WNBA's Washington Mystics.
