THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

• Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). **Brady currently ranks first in the NFL in passing yards and second in passing touchdowns.**



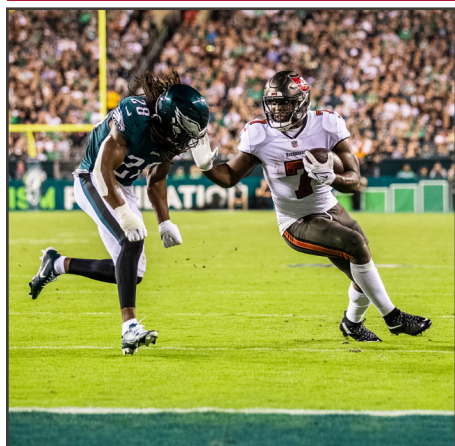

• Fournette has now recorded 100+ yards from scrimmage in three consecutive games for the first time since Weeks 4-8 of the 2019 season when he did so in five consecutive games.

THE BUZZ AROUND BOWLES' DEFENSE



NO. 27 TO NO. 6

Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020 and currently ranking ninth in 2021.

COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** (2008, 2010-12), Outside Linebackers Coach **Larry Foote** (2002-08; 2010-13) and Bears Secondary Coach **Deshea Townsend** (1998-2009) played together for the Pittsburgh Steelers.
- Buccaneers Inside Linebackers **Mike Caldwell** (2002) and Bears Offensive Quality Control Coach **Henry Burris** (2002) played together for the Chicago Bears.
- Buccaneers Defensive Quality Control Coach **Tim Atkins** (2012-13) and Bears Senior Defensive Assistant **Mike Pettine** (2013) coached together for the Buffalo Bills. **Atkins** (2014-15) and **Pettine** (2014-15) also coached together with the Cleveland Browns when Pettine was the team's head coach.
- Buccaneers Safeties Coach **Nick Rapone** and Bears Assistant Special Teams Coach **Brian Ginn** coached together at the University of Delaware from 2006-12, playing a role in 50 wins over the seven-season span. The duo coached two of the most successful seasons in Blue Hen football history, appearing in a pair of national championship games in 2007 and 2010. In those seasons, the Blue Hens posted a combined record of 23-7. Rapone left the program in 2013 to join Buccaneers Head Coach Bruce Arians' staff with the Arizona Cardinals, while Ginn remained with the program until joining the Bears in 2018.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.

Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

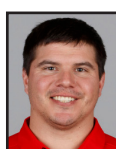

MATT NAGY



Matt Nagy is in his fourth season with the Chicago Bears in 2021 after being named the 16th head coach in franchise history on January 8th, 2018.

Nagy, the 2018 Associated Press and PFWA Coach of the Year, compiled a record of 28-20 in his first three seasons as the head coach in Chicago, with one division championship and two playoff appearances.

14 Bears players have been selected to the Pro Bowl in Nagy's first three seasons.

MATT NAGY AT A GLANCE

- The Bears finished the 2020 season 8-8 and clinched their second playoff berth in three seasons, falling to the No. 2 seed New Orleans Saints in the Wild Card round. The Bears started the season 5-1, their best start to a season since 2012, before hitting a six-game skid. Nagy and the Bears rebounded, however, and finished the season strong, winning three of their last four to clinch a playoff berth.
- The Bears finished the 2019 season 8-8 in a year that saw Allen Robinson become the first 1,000-yard receiver for the Bears since 2014. He finished the season with a career-high 98 receptions for 1,147 yards, becoming one of only three Bears in franchise history to haul in 95+ receptions and record over 1,100 yards in a season. He also led the team with seven TD receptions, the second most in his career. The Bears also were a force on the defensive side of the ball once again under Nagy and first-year defensive coordinator Chuck Pagano, allowing 18.6 points per game, the fewest in the NFC and No. 4 overall in the NFL.
- Nagy orchestrated a notable turnaround for the Bears in his first year in 2018, taking a 5-11 team in 2017 and transforming them into NFC North champions, capturing AP and PFWA Coach of the Year honors for his efforts. The Bears, who won nine of their last 10 that season, finished the regular season 12-4, the most wins since the 2006 NFC Championship season (13-3), and the most by a Bears head coach in their inaugural season in franchise history. In doing so, Chicago secured the NFC's No. 3 seed and hosted a playoff game for the first time since the 2010 NFC Championship.
- In 2018, the Bears ranked No. 1 in the NFL in takeaways (36), interceptions (27), INT returns for touchdowns (5), three-and-out percentage (.268), fewest first downs allowed (278/17.3 pg), fewest rushing yards allowed (80.0 pg) and fewest points allowed (17.7 ppg).
- Nagy spent five seasons in Kansas City, including three as quarterbacks coach (2013-15) and two as offensive coordinator (2016-17). With the Chiefs, Nagy worked closely with Alex Smith, who owned a 65.1 completion percentage in the five seasons working with Nagy, ranking first among all Chiefs QBs with at least 700 passing attempts.
- Nagy played collegiately at Delaware, setting more than 20 career passing records at the time, including career marks for passing yards (8,214) and touchdowns (58). Nagy earned All-America honors as a senior for the Blue Hens after setting single-season records in attempts (379), yards (3,436) and touchdowns (29).
- He and his wife, Stacey, have four sons: Brayden, Tate, Jaxon and Jett.
